GOOGLE AND MICROSOFT ARE BRINGING AI TO WORD, EXCEL, GMAIL AND MORE

Google and Microsoft are on a mission to remove the drudgery from computing, by bringing next-generation AI tools as add-ons to existing services.

On March 16, Microsoft announced an AI-powered system called Copilot will soon be introduced to its 365 suite apps including Word, Excel, PowerPoint, Outlook, and Teams.


The news came about two days after Google published a blog explaining its plans to embed AI into its Workspace apps such as Docs, Sheets, Slides, Meet and Chat. Collectively, millions of people use these apps each day. Bolstering them with AI could provide a major productivity boost – as long as security isn't an afterthought.

The advent of generative AI Until recently AI was mainly used for categorisation and identification tasks, such as recognising a number plate using a traffic camera.

Generative AI allows users to create new content, by applying deep-learning algorithms to big data. ChatGPT and DALL-E, among others, have already taken the world by storm.

Now, Microsoft and Google have found a more concrete way to bring generative AI into our offices and classrooms.

Like other generative AI tools, Copilot and Workspace AI are built on large language models (LLM) trained on massive amounts of data. Through this training, the systems have “learned” many rules and patterns that can be



applied to new content and contexts.

Microsoft's Copilot is being trialled with just 20 customers, with details about availability and pricing to be released “in the coming months”.

Copilot will be integrated across apps to help expedite tedious or repetitive tasks. For example, it will: 1. help users write, edit and summarise Word documents 2. turn ideas or summaries into full PowerPoint presentations 3. identify data trends in Excel and quickly create visualisations 4. “synthesise and manage” your Outlook inbox 5. provide real-time summaries of Teams meetings 6. bring together data from across documents, presentations, email, calendar, 7. notes and contacts to help write emails and summarise chats.

Assuming it executes these tasks effectively, Copilot will be a massive upgrade from Microsoft's original Office Assistant, Clippy.

Google's Workspace AI will offer similar capabilities for paying subscribers.

What's under the hood? Microsoft described Copilot as “a sophisticated processing and orchestration engine working behind the scenes to combine the power of LLMs, including GPT-4 [...]” We don't know specifically which data GPT-4 itself was trained on, just that it was a lot of data taken from the internet and licensed, according to OpenAI.

Google's Workspace AI is built on PaLM (Pathways Language Model), which was trained on a combination of books, Wikipedia articles, news articles, source codes, filtered webpages, and social media conversations.

Both systems are integrated into existing cloud infrastructure. This means all the data they are applied to will already be online and stored in company servers.

The tools will need full access to the relevant content in order to provide contextualised responses. For instance, Copilot can't distil a 16-page Word document into one page of bullet points without first analysing the text.

This raises the question: will users' information be used to train the underlying models? In relation to this point, Microsoft has said, “Copilot's large language models are not trained on customer content or on individual prompts.” Google has said: [...] private data is kept private, and not used in the broader foundation model training corpus.

These statements suggest the 16-page document itself won't be used to train the algorithms. Rather, Copilot and Workspace AI will process the data in real-time. Given the rush to develop such AI tools, there may be temptation to train such tools on “real” customer-specific data in the future. For now, however, it seems this is being explicitly excluded.

Usability concerns As many people noted following ChatGPT's release, text-based generative AI tools are prone to algorithmic bias. These concerns will extend to the new tools from Google and Microsoft.

The outputs of generative AI tools can be riddled with inaccuracies and prejudice. Microsoft's own Bing chatbot, which also runs on GPT-4, came under fire earlier this year for making outrageous claims.

Bias occurs when large volumes of data are processed without appropriate selection or understanding of the training data, and without proper oversight of training processes.

For example, much of the

content online is written in English – which is likely the main language spoken by the (mostly white and male) people developing AI tools. This underlying bias can influence the writing style and language constructs understood by, and subsequently replicated by, AI-driven systems.

For now, it's hard to say exactly how issues of bias might present in Copilot or Workspace AI. As one example, the systems may simply not work as effectively for people in non-English-speaking countries, or with diverse styles of English.

Security concerns One major vulnerability in Microsoft's and Google's AI tools is they could make it much easier for cybercriminals to bleed victims dry.

Whereas before a criminal may have needed to trawl through hundreds of files or emails to find specific data, they can now use AI-assisted features to quickly collate and extract what they need.

Also, since there's so far no indication of offline versions being made available, anyone wanting to use these systems will have to upload the relevant content online. Data uploaded online are at greater risk of being breached than data stored only on your computer or phone.

Finally, from a privacy perspective, it's not particularly inspiring to see yet more avenues through which the biggest corporations in the world can collect and synthesise our data.

APPLE WATCH OS 10 EXPECTED TO BE “FAIRLY EXTENSIVE UPGRADE”

With Apple's WWDC 2023 now official, we're beginning to get an inkling of what to expect on the software side across Apple's platforms. The latest tip comes from none other than Mark Gurman, who believes that watchOS 10 should be getting a fairly extensive upgrade this year with notable changes to the user interface. Details are still scarce on what these changes might actually be, but we're sure we'll be getting more leaks over the next two months leading up to WWDC. Gurman also goes on to state that we might not see any major hardware changes this year, considering Apple



introduced a new model, the Apple Watch Ultra, just last year. However, big hardware changes are expected to come in 2024 where Apple might shift to a larger, custom-built display for its watches. In a tweet, Gurman (@markgurman) expressed

that he believes watchOS 10 might have much more notable changes as compared to what's expected from iOS 17. watchOS 9 introduced a bunch of design changes and new features such as low-power mode, and continues to receive feature


updates with subsequent iterations. It'll be interesting to see what sort of big interface changes Apple is planning for watchOS 10.

Some expected changes could probably be new watch faces, workout modes, more native watch apps, etc. While we might not hear about new watch hardware at WWDC, some of the new features that Apple will talk about could point to what we could expect on the hardware side of things, come September. Gurman does mention in his tweet though that we probably won't see any major hardware changes this year for the Apple Watch, as those

are expected to happen in 2024. Earlier rumours suggested that Apple might skip the Watch Series 9 naming scheme and jump directly to Watch Series X, just like it did with the iPhone. This year, WWDC 2023 will take place from June 5 to 9 at Apple Park in Cupertino, California. Apple is expected to announce iOS 17, iPadOS 17, macOS 14, watchOS 10, and tvOS 17 at the event. It is also expected to unveil its Reality Pro AR headset, although we probably won't see this in stores until much later as mass production is reportedly delayed to later Q3 2023.

GOOGLE PIXEL 8 PRO MAY GET NEW NIGHT SIGHT FEATURE, SUGGESTS GOOGLE CAMERA 8.8 APK TEARDOWN

Google Pixel 8 series is expected to go official in May during the company's I/O 2023 event. The Pixel 7 successor is expected to debut with a complete camera overhaul and a recent APK (Android Package Kit) teardown of the latest Google Camera app adds more credibility to this rumour. Version 8.8 of the Google Camera app for Pixel smartphones reportedly points at a new photography feature on the upcoming Google Pixel 8. The alleged feature could blend multiple cameras to create more detailed Night Sight photos. The development was first



spotted by 9to5google while examining the Google Camera 8.8 app, a new version of Google's camera app for Pixel smartphones. As per the report, Google will

include a new feature on the Pixel 8 Pro that would combine multiple cameras to take improved Night Sight photos. The APK teardown of version 8.8 of the Google

Camera app for Pixel smartphones reportedly includes details of the Pixel 8 and Pixel 8 Pro and a reference to a "Multi-camera Super Res Zoom" feature. With the rumoured feature, both the main camera sensor and telephoto sensor will capture the same shot over an extended period and the Google Camera could merge them into a single Night Sight shot with more details. Last year's Pixel 7 Pro also offered similar functionality. It takes photos with both the main and telephoto cameras and enhances the centre portion of the photos with details that wouldn't normally

be visible. Google is yet to confirm the development of the Pixel 8 series. Therefore, this information should be taken with a pinch of salt. Google's I/O 2023 event will take place on May 10 and the company is expected to tease the Pixel 8 series during its annual conference. A new Tensor chip based on Samsung's Exynos 2300 SoC is expected to power the new handsets. The Pixel 8 Pro could feature a flat 6.52-inch display with a centre-aligned hole punch cutout for the selfie camera. It is said to measure 162.6 x 76.5 x 8.7mm as well.

NOKIA C12 PRO WITH ANDROID 12 (GO EDITION) LAUNCHED IN INDIA: PRICE, SPECIFICATIONS



Nokia C12 Pro, a budget-friendly smartphone, has been launched in India by HMD Global. This handset is available in two storage

configurations and three colour options. The newly unveiled Nokia C12 Pro is powered by an octa-core chipset. The Nokia C12 was

recently launched in India with a 6.3-inch HD+ display and an 8-megapixel rear camera. This budget-entry offering by HMD global is powered by an octa-core Unisoc 9863A1 chipset and comes with 2GB RAM and 64GB internal storage. Nokia C12 Pro price in India The Nokia C12 Pro is a low-cost smartphone that is available in India in two storage options. The lower-end model with 2GB of RAM and 64GB of internal storage is priced at Rs. 6,999. The variant with 3GB RAM variant with 64GB of internal storage is available for Rs. 7,499. Both variants of the

smartphone support up to 2GB of virtual RAM. The device is available in three colours - light mint, charcoal, and dark cyan. In comparison, the Nokia C12, also offered in similar colour variants, is priced at Rs. 5,999 for the single 2GB + 64GB storage variant. Nokia C12 Pro specifications, features Featuring a 6.3-inch IPS LCD with an HD+ resolution and a refresh rate of 60Hz, the dual SIM-supported Nokia C12 Pro smartphone is powered by an unnamed octa-core SoC. The phone boots Android 12 (Go Edition) out of the box and Nokia will provide

two years of regular security patches and 12 months of replacement guarantee for the Nokia C12 Pro. For optics, the Nokia C12 Pro sports an 8-megapixel rear camera along with an LED flash and a 5-megapixel front camera. HMD Global did not reveal any other specifications of the device. The Nokia C12 with a 6.3-inch HD+ display with an aspect ratio of 20:9, has similar specifications to the Pro model, but is backed by an octa-core Unisoc 9863A1 chipset and packs a 3,000mAh removable battery that supports 5W wired charging.

INDIA'S DEBATED 1% TDS ON CRYPTO TRANSFERS ADDED MILLIONS TO GOVERNMENT TREASURY

The outcry from crypto traders and investors went unheard after Indian finance minister Nirmala Sitharaman failed to revise the controversial 1 percent TDS collection on each crypto transaction. In the last nine months, this TDS collection has said to have fetched over \$19 million (roughly Rs. 157 crore) to the government treasury. The detail was disclosed to the Parliament recently by Pankaj Chaudhary, who is the Minister of State for Finance in the country. The data tracks ten months since the TDS law went live last July in India. "Direct tax collected by way of tax deducted at source under

section 1945 of the Income-tax Act, 1961, on payments made upon transfer of Virtual Digital Assets, aggregates to Rs. 157.9 crore upto 20/03/2023 for FY 2022-23," Chaudhary said in a written update to the Upper House. Indians, last June, began to see one percent tax deductions on each crypto transaction. This essentially means that one percent TDS is being levied on every step around the purchase, trade, and deposit of crypto assets. Not just on cryptocurrencies, this one percent TDS is also be charged on the transactions of other VDAs as well, such as non-fungible tokens (NFTs) and other



metaverse elements. Between June and November last year, the TDS collection from crypto transactions reportedly amounted to \$7.4 million (roughly Rs. 60 crore), Chaudhary had informed at the time. In the last five months, this

amount has spiked by \$11.6 million (roughly Rs. 95 crore) — indicating a rise in crypto transactions in India. Time and again, members of India's crypto community have urged the finance ministry to revisit the 1 percent TDS and consider reducing it to promote the growth of the overall crypto sector. In a tweet, Sathvik Vishwakarma, the CEO of Unocoin crypto exchange reacted to Chaudhary's disclosure, calling the TDS rule a distraction in the growth of the digital assets industry in India. The government of India believes that by imposing one percent tax deducted at source (TDS) on

each crypto transaction, it would be easier to keep a track of them despite the element of anonymity that crypto transactions entail. The crypto community in India is set to surpass the US, UK, Russia, and Japan in terms of adoption this year. As per a recent report by Statista, India's crypto community is expected to envelop over 156 million users by the end of 2023. Amid the expansion of the sector, the government of India, via its tax laws around crypto, is looking to curb any potential abuse of digital assets for illegal activities like money laundering and terror financing.



CYBERABAD POLICE ISSUES NOTICES TO 11 ORGANISATIONS IN PROBE OF DATA THEFT

The Cyberabad police has issued notices to as many as 11 organisations, including three banks, a social media giant and an Information Technology services company, asking their representatives to appear before it in connection with a breach of data of 66.9 crore persons across the country, a senior police official said on Sunday. The Cyberabad police on Saturday said they arrested one person, Vinay Bhardwaj, who was allegedly involved in stealing, holding and selling personal and confidential data of 66.9 crore individuals and organisations belonging to 24 states and



eight metropolitan cities, maintained in 104 categories. The accused person was found in possession of the data of students of ed-tech organisations as well as the GST details of persons and companies, and the

consumer/customer data of major organisations such as road transport corporations of various states, major ecommerce portals, social media platforms and fintech companies.

The 11 organisations to whom

the notices were issued include two PSU banks and one private bank, a social media giant, an IT services company, an online grocery seller, a digital payments app and an online insurance platform, police said.

The 11 organisations' representatives have been told to appear before the police during the next one week to furnish details on how the companies maintained their databases, what procedures and policies were followed in this regard and who could access the data. This could help investigators ascertain how the database was leaked and accessed by

an "unauthorised" person, among other relevant details, police said.

The arrested accused was operating through a website, 'InspireWebz', at Faridabad, Haryana and selling databases to clients through cloud drive links, police said. In March, Cyberabad Police arrested seven people of a gang who were allegedly involved in the theft and sale of sensitive data of the government and important organisations, including details of 2.55 lakh defence personnel as well as the personal and confidential data of about 16.8 crore citizens across the country.

SURVEY SHOWS 'HIGH-LEVEL' PUBLIC SUPPORT FOR SOME FORMS OF GOVERNMENT SURVEILLANCE

A survey has shown a "high-level" of public support for certain forms of government surveillance like through CCTV cameras even as the poor and groups such as Dalits and Muslims have the "least" trust in the police.

Surveyors from NGO Common Cause and the Lokniti programme of the Centre for the Study of Developing Societies spoke to a total of 9,779 individuals in 12 states and Union Territories before they released the "Status of Policing in India Report 2023: Surveillance and the Question of Privacy" on Friday in the national capital. "The study also involved focus group discussions with domain experts, in-depth interviews with serving police officials, and an analysis of media coverage of surveillance-related issues," according to a statement. The findings of the survey, according to the statement, indicate a "high-level of public support for certain forms of government surveillance, but also a lack of public



awareness regarding critical issues such as the Pegasus scandal and the Puttaswamy case." While the Pegasus refers to the alleged usage of military grade spyware for surveillance, the judgment in the Puttaswamy case formally recognised right to privacy as a fundamental right.

The survey report states that the support for any form of surveillance is "directly proportional" to the respondent's socio-economic status, i.e. the richer the respondent the more the support, the survey found. The poor, Adivasis, Dalits,

and Muslims trust the police the least, it found.

Some of the key findings of the survey state that "only one in four people strongly feel that CCTVs carry a risk of illegal mass surveillance." "Nearly three out of four people strongly believe that CCTVs help monitor and reduce crimes," it said.

The survey found, according to the press statement, that about half of the respondents supported the collection of biometric details of suspects while Adivasis and Muslims were "most critical" of the police collecting biometric details of all suspects.

More than one out of two people strongly support the use of drones by the armed forces, government, and police. However, farmers and the poorest are most likely to oppose drone usage by government agencies, the survey found.

"One out of two people fully support the use of FRT (facial recognition technology) by the government, and police. People are four times more likely to strongly support the use of FRT by government agencies, compared to its use by private entities," the survey found. Nearly two out of three respondents believe that political parties surveil citizens for electoral gains, it said.

The survey also found that large sections of the respondents feel government surveillance by CCTVs (52 percent), drones (30 percent) and FRT (25 percent), etc. to suppress protests and political movements are "justified" to a great extent.

However, it said, the respondents from Punjab are least likely to support government surveillance during protests, while those from Gujarat are most likely to support it.

Retired Uttar Pradesh Police and BSF Director General Prakash Singh said the authorisation for putting up surveillance tools should only be handled by the government.

"In India there are certain agencies that have been authorised to put people under surveillance, but the sanction must come from the Home Ministry. About one lakh sanctions for surveillance are given every year, which works out to about 250 per day. Can there be judicious application of mind with such a large number?" "There is no liability provision, if it is found that a wrong person has been put under surveillance. Due application of mind is not happening today," Singh, one of the most prominent faces who worked for police reforms in the country, said.

A dedicated impact lab aimed at developing and working around blockchain technology has been set up at the Hyderabad campus of the Indian School of Business (ISB), complete with an Ethereum virtual machine, Hyperledger Fabric, and support for multi-chain ecosystems — making for an adequate space for testing blockchain-based protocols and solutions. The launch of this facility comes at a time when international blockchain firms are turning to India, seeking developers and technologically advanced engineers. ISB's Blockchain Impact Lab



will operate as a physical facility, as well as a virtual establishment to ensure that it can benefit developers outside ISB as well. Training sessions around

blockchain uses will also be provided via this lab to benefit developers. DLabs, which was set up within the ISB campus last year to incubate potential

start-ups, has teamed up with S&P Global, an intelligence and tech firm, to back up the Blockchain Impact Lab. “We are providing a platform for students, faculty, start-ups and upcoming entrepreneurs to create a significant societal impact,” Nilam Patel, Managing Director - India Operations, S&P Global India, said in a prepared statement. India, that has the largest and the youngest population in the world, is known to produce skilled engineers. The government of India has been putting a lot of focus on supporting up-and-coming startups in the nation and

blockchain is a new technology that has triggered an interest in India. In January this year, government-backed think tank NITI Aayog launched a blockchain module to help local developers explore the potential of the sector with experimental use-cases, trials, and possible errors. The move backed Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman's repeated statements over India's inclination to explore cryptocurrencies' underlying blockchain tech to its potential, despite scepticism towards cryptocurrencies in general.

JAPAN AIMS TO TREBLE SALES OF DOMESTICALLY
PRODUCED MICROCHIPS TO JPY 15 TRILLION BY 2030

Japan's industry ministry said on Monday it aimed to treble sales of semiconductors made in Japan to JPY 15 trillion (roughly Rs. 9,285,004,593,300 crore) by 2030 as Tokyo strives to boost domestic microchip production following global supply chain snarls. Japan sees microchips as strategic products to strengthen its economic

security and is providing hefty subsidies to Taiwan Semiconductor Manufacturing Co (TSMC) and others to build plants in Japan or have them expand existing facilities. The ministry plans to put the sales target in Japan's semiconductor and digital industry strategy, which will be updated by the middle of the year.

Japan has seen its share in the global microchip market tumble from 50 percent in the late 1980s to around 10 percent, outperformed by nimbler rivals with deep pockets such as South Korea's Samsung Electronics. Last week, Japan said it would restrict exports of 23 types of semiconductor manufacturing equipment,

aligning its technology trade controls with a US push to curb China's ability to make advanced chips. Japan, home to major global chip equipment makers such as Nikon and Tokyo Electron, did not specify China as the target of the measures, saying equipment makers would need to seek export permission for all regions. "We are fulfilling our

responsibility as a technological nation to contribute to international peace and stability," Minister for Economy, Trade and Industry Yasutoshi Nishimura told a news conference. Japan wants to stop advanced technology being used for military purposes and does not have one specific country in mind with the measures, he said.




