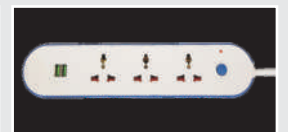

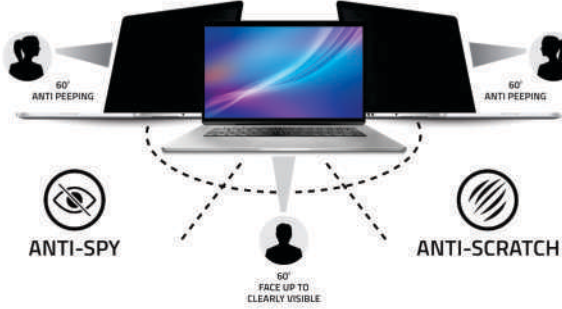

## BUDGET 2023: BSNL TO USE ALLOCATED RS. 53,000 CRORE FOR UPGRADING TO 4G, 5G NETWORK

State-run BSNL will use about Rs. 53,000 crore in upgrading its network to 4G and 5G this year as well as revamping landline network across the country, Union Minister for IT and Telecom Ashwini Vaishnaw said on Wednesday.

The Government has announced a capital infusion of Rs. 52,937 crore in BSNL during the next fiscal year starting April 1, 2023.

While speaking on Budget 2023-24, the minister said BSNL's capital infusion is part of the Rs. 1.64 lakh crore revival package announced last year and most of the balance sheet items of BSNL have already been addressed.

"BSNL has raised new debt using the sovereign guarantees which were announced in the package. Now, the physical installation of new towers, upgradation from 2G, 3G to 4G and 5G and a major revamp in the landline systems of the MTNL



and BSNL network will be taken up in this year using the capital allocation of Rs. 53,000 crore which has been made for BSNL," Vaishnaw said. Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman in her speech announced setting up of 100 labs for developing applications using 5G services in engineering institutions. In the receipt budget for 2023-24, the government has raised non-tax revenue collection estimates from the telecom sector by 30 per cent to Rs 89,469.17 crore. The government has

allocated Rs. 1.23 lakh crore for postal and telecom projects. Total allocation includes Rs. 97,579.05 crore for the Department of Telecom and Rs. 25,814 crore for Postal projects. The government has allocated Rs. 2,158 crore for Optical Fibre Cable based network for Defence Services and Rs. 715.8 crore for telecom projects in the North Eastern states. Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman in her speech announced setting up of 100 labs for developing applications using 5G

services in engineering institutions.

State-run BSNL will use about Rs 53,000 crore in upgrading its network to 4G and 5G this year as well as revamping landline network across the country, Union Minister for IT and Telecom Ashwini Vaishnaw said on Wednesday. The government has revised the revenue estimate to Rs. 68,784 crore for the current fiscal from the earlier projection of Rs. 52,806 crore in the previous budget. The actual revenue of the government in 2021-22 was Rs. 85,828 crore.

The non-tax revenue from the communication sector mainly relates to licencing fees from telecom operators and receipts on account of spectrum usage charges The Rs. 25,814 crore allocated to the Department of Posts includes a Rs. 250 crore capital infusion in the India Post Payments Bank.

"Revenue realisation in telecom is consistent. Telecom today is a sunrise industry and this is reflected in the higher revenue realisation which has been budgeted," the minister said.

## SAMSUNG GALAXY BOOK 3 SERIES WITH UP TO 13TH GEN INTEL CORE I9 CPUS LAUNCHED

Samsung unveiled the Galaxy Book 3 series on Wednesday during Galaxy Unpacked 2023. This lineup includes the flagship Galaxy Book 3 Ultra, which packs up to 13th Gen Intel Core i9 CPU, along with a dedicated Nvidia GeForce RTX 4000 series laptops graphics card. The South Korean tech giant has also debuted the Galaxy Book 3 Pro 360 2-in-1 convertible laptop with S Pen support. In addition, Samsung has launched the Galaxy Book 3 Pro thin and light laptop with a clamshell form factor. These laptops come with the Samsung Multi Control feature that enables users to control their PC, Galaxy Tab, and Galaxy smartphone with the Galaxy Book 3 series' keyboard and trackpad. Users can also convert their Galaxy Tab into an additional screen with the Second Screen feature. Samsung Galaxy Book 3 Ultra, Galaxy Book 3 Pro 360, Galaxy Book 3 price, availability  
The Galaxy Book 3 Ultra will be available to purchase in select markets starting on February 22. It will come in Graphite colour. It will be available to pre-order from February 14 starting at \$2,199 (roughly Rs. 1,80,000).



Meanwhile, the Galaxy Book 3 Pro 360 will get 5G connectivity options starting at \$1,399 (roughly Rs. 1,15,000). The Galaxy Book 3 Pro will get 14-inch and 16-inch size options that will start at \$1,249 (roughly Rs. 1,02,500). The latter two laptops will go on sale in the country in select markets starting from February 17. They will be available in Graphite and Beige colour options. Samsung Galaxy Book 3 Ultra specifications  
Galaxy Book 3 Ultra, the top-of-the-line laptop from Samsung features a 16-inch Dynamic AMOLED 2X display with a 3K (2,880x1,800 pixels) resolution, adaptive 120Hz refresh, and 400 nits of brightness. It is powered by either a 13th Gen Intel Core i7 processor or a 13th Gen Intel Core i9 processor, depending

on the model. There is also either an Nvidia GeForce RTX 4070 laptop GPU or a GeForce RTX 4050 laptop GPU. The Galaxy Book 3 Ultra boots Windows 11 out of the box. It supports Wi-Fi 6E and Bluetooth 5.1 wireless connectivity. There is up to 32GB of LPDDR5 RAM and up to 1TB of SSD storage. It gets a full-HD webcam with a studio-quality dual mic setup. This laptop is also equipped with AKG quad speakers enhanced by Dolby Atmos technology. It packs a 76Wh battery and comes with support for 100W USB Type-C fast charging. The Galaxy Book 3 Ultra sports a backlit keyboard with a three-row numeric layout. This laptop measures 355.4x250.4x16.5mm and measures about 1.79kg, the company says. # YOUNG PEOPLE UNAWARE OF IT ROLES IN FINANCIAL SERVICES

Young people are unaware of technology roles and opportunities available in the financial services industry, according to careers firm Investment 2020. Investment 2020 partners with firms to provide apprenticeships and careers information to young people. It has found that young people often don't know what roles they could be entering, and perceive technology roles in the financial services industry as "masculine".

Karis Stander, managing director of Investment 2020, said: "We are finding there is a disconnect between the opportunities available and the awareness or the desire for young people to take these opportunities."

Stander said students are often put off pursuing IT careers or apprenticeship routes because they think they do not have the skills to enter the job market.

"Some people are put off because they think they need formal studies, but there's something for everyone. We need creative thinkers and we need creative problem solvers," she said.

Many industry professionals have addressed the importance of soft skills, as well as technical skills, when filling IT roles. Stander explained that firms are looking at "the whole person",



as well as a candidate's grades.

"The industry has huge social impact locally and globally. We want the right attitude and we want the aptitude," she added. Joysy John, chief industry officer for Ada College, said efficient teams need people with a mixture of creative and technical skills, but firms cannot find the candidates they need.

"There's a huge supply and demand gap. Employers can't find the talent they're looking for. Even though there's this opportunity in technology, not many young people are studying computing," she said.

**Diversity in the IT industry**

According to John, the "statistics haven't changed much" since she completed a computer science degree and became a woman in IT. She said firms should be focusing on promoting a diverse environment to get ahead.

John said young people should not have to come from a "white, rich" background to bag a job in technology, and that more diverse IT teams will ensure the different types of skill needed to create good products.

"We all use technology today, but 80% of code is written by men," she said. "When you think of teams that are efficient, you need diverse types of skills." But part of the problem, she said, is that apprenticeships are not always considered a good alternative to a university degree.

"There are a lot of benefits to starting a tech career as an apprentice – it is a real alternative," she said. Supporting apprenticeships

Holly Fryett, said she originally did not intend to apply for a technology job because she believed the technology industry was a flooded market.

Fryett's decision to apply for

an apprenticeship at M&G Investments, rather than go the traditional university supported by her parents.

She realised technology jobs require a mix of skills, such as attention to detail, problem solving and teamwork, as opposed to a focus on just technical skills – something she claimed apprenticeships are good at teaching.

"If you went to university and studied computing, you won't learn as much as you do in the work environment," she said.

"Practical learning is much more valuable."

Fryett admitted she searched for alternatives to university on the internet, rather than have help from a career counsellor. She said it is important to let young people know "they have other options" when considering what to do after school.

Harrison Crossley, security analyst trainee in information security for Schroders, said his parents were also supportive of his decision not to opt for a university-driven career path. There are a lot of benefits to starting a tech career as an apprentice – it is a real alternative

Crossley said he felt people his age who had gone to university – as opposed to undertake an apprenticeship – weren't as ready for the working world. He feels it is

important for young people to attend events and build up a network.

"Half of what I know now, I had no clue about when I started. Technology is only going to get bigger," he said.

"Finance is branded by the public as a demon that's doing bad and ruining everything, but the finance industry is one of the best to work in – it's so different."

**IT needs communicators**

Andrew Rydon, CTO of IT at Henderson Global Investors, said a lot of technology roles do not require technical skills.

"Some of the technology people don't know that much about tech. Don't constrain yourself to thinking technology is all about tech," he said.

Rydon said there are an array of roles young people can step into, both in technology and finance. He added that the pace of change driven by technology means it's a "phenomenal time" to join technology roles and the finance industry.

"We're interested in what tech is going to do to the finance industry," Rydon said. "This is not a boring industry and tech is not a boring subject."

Rydon said soft skills in new candidates, as well as traits such as "enthusiasm and curiosity", are just as important as technical skills when recruiting for an IT role.

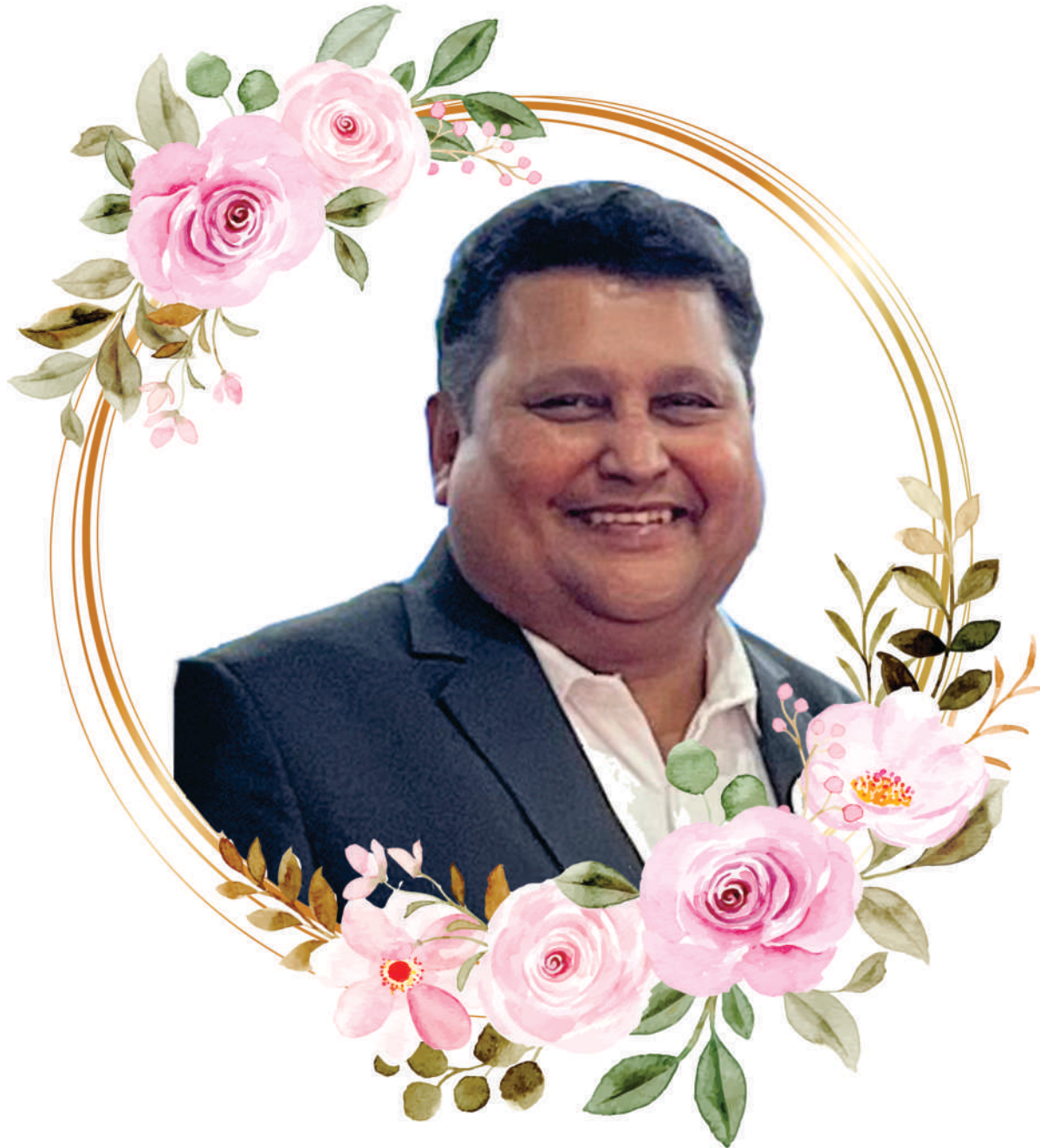

# APPLE COULD REPORT ITS FIRST DECLINE IN QUARTERLY REVENUE IN NEARLY 4 YEARS, SAY ANALYSTS

Apple is expected to report its first decline in quarterly revenue in nearly four years after strict COVID-19 curbs in China rapped the economy and related protests upended iPhone production at its biggest supplier Foxconn.

Investors will look for details on how Chief Executive Tim Cook is trying to bolster demand in a weak economy that has prompted mass layoffs in the tech industry, a move Apple has so far avoided thanks to frugal hiring during the pandemic.

"With supply chain challenges largely normalized, we now believe Apple is entering a period of slower demand due to macro factors," said Cowen analyst Krish Sankar, adding that he expects 2 percent fewer iPhone units to be sold in



2023.

The world's biggest public company is expected to report on Thursday that iPhone sales fell about 5 percent for the all-important holiday quarter, according to Refinitiv.

The last time iPhone sales slipped was in the August-October period in 2020,

months into the COVID-19 pandemic.

UBS analysts expect iPhone sales to have held up better in the United States than China and Europe, as the economies reeled from the impact of COVID-19 and the Russia-Ukraine war.

Some demand for the iPhone will likely be pushed into the

current quarter after supply restrictions in the first quarter and some demand lost due to lack of product availability in the holiday period, BofA analyst Wamsi Mohan said.

The services business, a key growth engine for the company and home to Apple's music and video streaming services, is set to post its lowest revenue growth for the holiday quarter — another fallout of consumers limiting spending.

THE CONTEXT

The disruption at the world's biggest iPhone plant in Zhengzhou, China triggered a rare warning from Apple in November and limited stocks of its higher-end iPhone 14 models during what is typically its biggest sales quarter, powered by product launches and the holidays.

Greater China, including Hong Kong, is key to Apple's fortunes, contributing roughly a fifth to annual revenue. The Cupertino, California-based tech behemoth had in 2019 pared its total sales forecast due to an economic slowdown in the country following the Sino-US trade war.

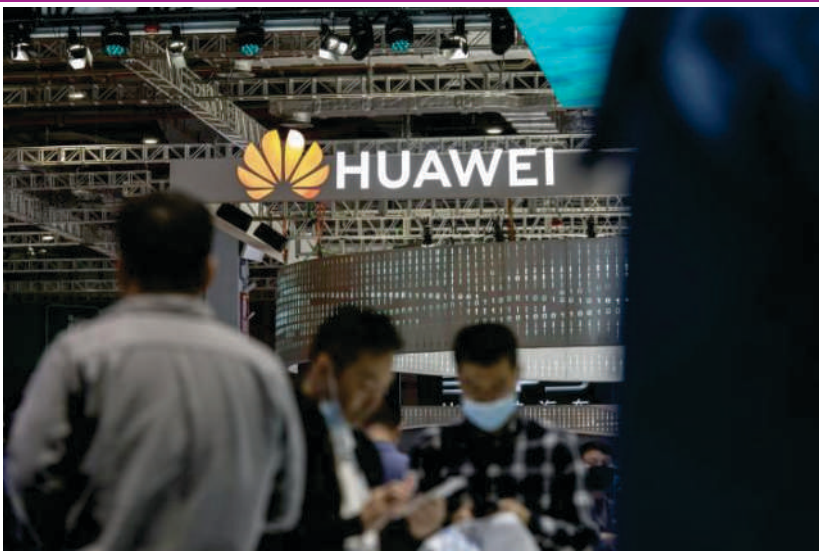
Analysts, however, expect a much-faster recovery this time as factories have restarted in China and Apple diversifies its production footprint with plants in India.

"Commentary from luxury goods companies indicates China is rebounding quickly, which implies Mar-quarter Chinese iPhone sales should be better than expected," Evercore ISI analysts said in a note.

# HUAWEI SAYS BUSINESS BACK TO NORMAL AFTER OVERCOMING SEVERAL US RESTRICTIONS

Huawei Technologies Co. posted its third straight quarter of growth, declaring a return to normalcy after overcoming a plethora of US restrictions this year.

The company's sales rose 7.2 percent to CNY 191 billion (roughly Rs. 2,27,820 crore) in the December quarter, according to Bloomberg's calculations off annual figures, after carving out new income streams from areas such as smart cars and cloud services. 2022 sales stood at CNY 636.9 billion (roughly Rs. 7,59,520 crore), the Shenzhen-based company said, up marginally from a year earlier. Huawei is trying to open up new markets and businesses after US tech export restrictions gutted its smartphone business — briefly the world's largest —



and curtailed the sale of advanced gear in developed markets. Among those trade restrictions is a ban on contract chipmakers producing semiconductors designed by Huawei, effectively kneecapping its HiSilicon design business.

Rotating Chairman Eric Xu

warned in an annual new year's message to employees of macroeconomic uncertainty in 2023, though he made no mention of China's abrupt reversal on Covid policy. That about-face has spurred concerns about the fallout on economies from a subsequent surge in

infections.

But Xu said longer-term demand for technology remains intact. He didn't specify how the company might overcome export restrictions, but Huawei has spent much of the past three years developing, researching and sourcing alternatives to American components. "In 2022, we successfully pulled ourselves out of crisis mode. US restrictions are now our new normal, and we're back to business as usual," Xu said. "The macro environment may be rife with uncertainty, but what we can be certain about is that digitalization and decarbonization are the way forward, and they're where future opportunities lie."

Huawei's also sought out alternative sources of income

by selling patents, technology services and wireless gear to new customers from automakers to coal mines and industrial parks. It began levying royalties from the world's biggest smartphone brands, including Apple and Samsung.

The Chinese company has signed more than 20 patent license agreements this year, covering smartphones, connected vehicles, networking and the Internet of Things, according to Alan Fan, the company's global head of IP.

"We've managed to keep our heads above the water because we fought together, united as one," Xu wrote. "2023 will be the first year that we return to business as usual with external restrictions still in place."

# IPHONE 15'S A17 CHIP EXPECTED TO FOCUS ON BATTERY LIFE OVER POWER: REPORT

iPhone 14 series was launched earlier this year with its Pro models featuring the Apple A16 Bionic chip. Now, a recent report has suggested that the Cupertino company will equip the iPhone 15 series Pro model with its new chipset — the Apple A17. It is believed that Apple is emphasising on delivering an improved battery life with this chip, while its performance aspect takes a back seat.

Apple is likely to use Taiwan Semiconductor Manufacturing Company's (TSMC) 3nm process to manufacture the Apple A17 chip.

A recent MySmartPrice report claims that the Apple A17 chip featured on the iPhone 15 series may lean towards providing an improved battery life. This speculation stems from the rumours that suggest TSMC's 3nm

process would result in chips that offer increased power and improved energy efficiency.

TSMC chairman Mark Liu was reportedly quoted as saying that the 3nm process chips would offer better performance than the 5nm process chips, while also requiring about 35 percent less power. Providing a vague statement for power, but giving a somewhat concrete

figure for battery life could be taken as a clue to what we can expect from TSMC's 3nm chips. The iPhone 15 Pro and iPhone 15 Pro Max models are expected to feature this 3nm Apple A17 chip. Meanwhile, the non-Pro variant could get the Apple A16 Bionic chipset. Furthermore, the iPhone 15 series could also get a boost in the RAM department. They may come with 8GB of RAM,

instead of the 6GB memory offered on the iPhone 14 handsets.

Apple may also equip the iPhone 15 smartphones with Sony's advanced image sensor. This sensor is expected to offer double the saturation signal level in each pixel than a conventional sensor. It may also be able to capture increased light reducing overexposure or underexposure in images.



# TOYOTA INDIA WARNS OF POSSIBLE DATA BREACH EXPOSING CUSTOMERS' PERSONAL INFORMATION

A data breach at Toyota Motor's Indian business might have exposed some customers' personal information, it said on Sunday. Toyota India said it has notified the relevant Indian authorities of the data breach at Toyota Kirloskar Motor, a joint venture with Indian conglomerate Kirloskar Group.

"Toyota Kirloskar Motor (TKM) has been notified by one of its service providers of an incident that might have exposed personal information of some of TKM's customers on the Internet", TKM said in an emailed



statement without disclosing the size of the data breach or number of customers affected.

An unrelated issue at Toyota Motor's T-Connect service potentially leaked about

296,000 pieces of customer information, it said last October.

At the time, Toyota Group had stated it had found that about 296,000 pieces of customer information from its T-

Connect service might have been leaked.

Back in October, the firm said 296,019 email addresses and customer numbers of those using T-Connect, a telematics service that connects vehicles via a network, were potentially leaked. The affected customers are individuals who signed up to the service's website using their email addresses since July 2017.

A third-party access could not be confirmed from the access history of the data server where the information was stored based on security experts' investigation, Toyota

said in a statement at the time.

At the same time, it added that third-party access "could not be completely ruled out." There was no possibility, though, that users' sensitive personal information, such as names, phone numbers or credit card information, were leaked, Toyota had stated.

The Japanese automaker had not confirmed cases of the information being misused but cautioned that there was a possibility of spamming, phishing scams and unsolicited email messages being sent to the users' email addresses.

# SAMSUNG GALAXY S23, GALAXY S23+, GALAXY S23 ULTRA PRICE IN INDIA REVEALED: ALL DETAILS

Samsung launched its much-awaited Galaxy S23 lineup at the Galaxy Unpacked event on Wednesday, finally officially showcasing its flagship phones of the year after months of rumours and leaks. The Galaxy S23 lineup, which includes the Galaxy S23, Galaxy S23+, and the Galaxy S23 Ultra, is powered by a custom Snapdragon 8 Gen 2 SoC. The top-of-the-line Galaxy S23 Ultra features a quad rear camera setup, headlined by a 200-megapixel camera, while the vanilla Galaxy S23 and the Galaxy S23+ sport the same triple rear camera module, led by a 50-megapixel main sensor.

Samsung Galaxy S23, Galaxy S23+, Galaxy S23 Ultra price in India, availability The vanilla Samsung Galaxy S23 is priced Rs. 74,999 in India for the base 8GB + 128GB storage variant and Rs. 79,999 for the 8GB + 256GB option, while the baseline 8GB + 256GB model of the Galaxy S23+ will cost you Rs. 94,999 and the 8GB + 512GB variant is priced at Rs. 1,04,999. The Galaxy S23 Ultra's pricing begins at Rs. 1,24,999 for the 12GB + 256GB storage variant. The 12GB + 512GB model comes in at Rs. 1,34,999 and the top-of-the-line 12GB + 1TB variant is priced at Rs. 1,54,999.

All three handsets will go on sale starting February 17 and will be available in Phantom



Black, Cream, Green, and Lavender colourways. The Galaxy S23 Ultra will also be available in four additional colours — Red, Graphite, Lime, and Sky Blue — exclusively on Samsung's website. Samsung's latest smartphones are currently up for pre-booking.

Samsung also confirmed that its new flagship phones sold in India will be locally made. "All Galaxy S23 smartphones sold in India will be manufactured at the company's Noida factory. Samsung already fulfils a majority of the domestic demand in India through local manufacturing at the Noida factory," Samsung said in a statement.

Samsung Galaxy S23 specifications

# CHATGPT PLUS PAID SUBSCRIPTION PLAN ANNOUNCED: THE PROMISES, PITFALLS AND PANIC

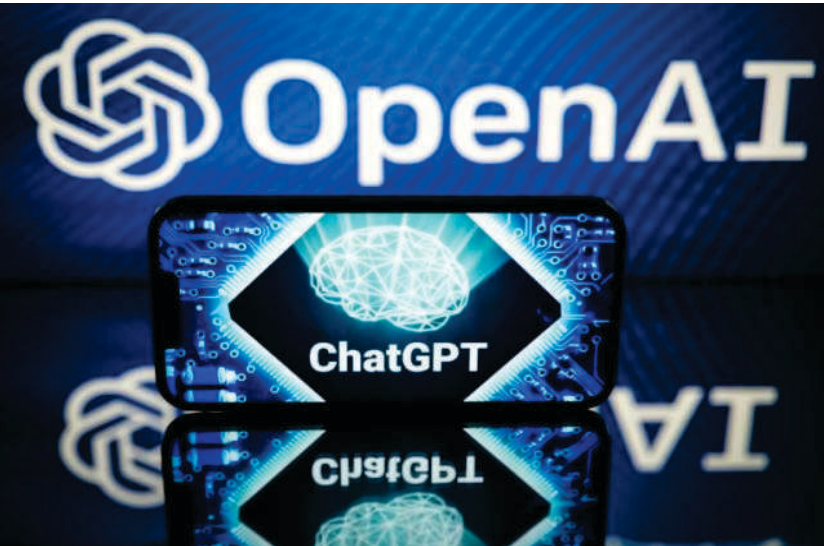
Excitement around ChatGPT -- an easy-to-use AI chatbot that can deliver an essay or computer code upon request and within seconds -- has sent schools into panic and turned Big Tech green with envy.

The potential impact of ChatGPT on society remains complicated and unclear even as its creator Wednesday announced a paid subscription version in the United States.

Here is a closer look at what ChatGPT is (and is not): Is this a turning point?

It is entirely possible that November's release of ChatGPT by California company OpenAI will be remembered as a turning point in introducing a new wave of artificial intelligence to the wider public.

What is less clear is whether ChatGPT is actually a breakthrough with some critics calling it a brilliant PR move that helped OpenAI score billions of dollars in investments from Microsoft. Yann LeCun, Chief AI Scientist at Meta and professor at New York University, believes "ChatGPT is not a particularly interesting scientific advance," calling the app a "flashy demo" built by talented engineers.



LeCun, speaking to the Big Technology Podcast, said ChatGPT is void of "any internal model of the world" and is merely churning "one word after another" based on inputs and patterns found on the internet.

"When working with these AI models, you have to remember that they're slot machines, not calculators," warned Haomiao Huang of Kleiner Perkins, the Silicon Valley venture capital firm. "Every time you ask a question and pull the arm, you get an answer that could be marvelous... or not... The failures can be extremely unpredictable," Huang wrote in Ars Technica, the tech news website.

Just like Google ChatGPT is powered by an AI language model that is nearly

three years old -- OpenAI's GPT-3 -- and the chatbot only uses a part of its capability.

The true revolution is the humanlike chat, said Jason Davis, research professor at Syracuse University.

"It's familiar, it's conversational and guess what? It's kind of like putting in a Google search request," he said. ChatGPT's rockstar-like success even shocked its creators at OpenAI, which received billions in new financing from Microsoft in January.

"Given the magnitude of the economic impact we expect here, more gradual is better," OpenAI CEO Sam Altman said in an interview to StrictlyVC, a newsletter.

"We put GPT-3 out almost three years ago... so the incremental update from that

to ChatGPT, I felt like should have been predictable and I want to do more introspection on why I was sort of miscalibrated on that," he said.

The risk, Altman added, was startling the public and policymakers and on Tuesday his company unveiled a tool for detecting text generated by AI amid concerns from teachers that students may rely on artificial intelligence to do their homework.

What now?

From lawyers to speechwriters, from coders to journalists, everyone is waiting breathlessly to feel the disruption caused by ChatGPT. OpenAI just launched a paid version of the chatbot -- \$20 (roughly Rs. 1,600) per month for an improved and faster service.

For now, officially, the first significant application of OpenAI's tech will be for Microsoft software products. Though details are scarce, most assume that ChatGPT-like capabilities will turn up on the Bing search engine and in the Office suite.

"Think about Microsoft Word. I don't have to write an essay or an article, I just have to tell Microsoft Word what I wanted to write with a prompt," said Davis.

He believes influencers on TikTok and Twitter will be the earliest adopters of this so-called generative AI since going viral requires huge amounts of content and ChatGPT can take care of that in no time.

This of course raises the spectre of disinformation and spamming carried out at an industrial scale.

For now, Davis said the reach of ChatGPT is very limited by computing power, but once this is ramped up, the opportunities and potential dangers will grow exponentially.

And much like the ever-imminent arrival of self-driving cars that never quite happens, experts disagree on whether that is a question of months or years.

Ridicule

LeCun said Meta and Google have refrained from releasing AI as potent as ChatGPT out of fear of ridicule and backlash. Quieter releases of language-based bots - like Meta's Blenderbot or Microsoft's Tay for example - were quickly shown capable of generating racist or inappropriate content.

Tech giants have to think hard before releasing something "that is going to spew nonsense" and disappoint, he said.

# BITCOIN, ETH RALLY WITH PROFITS, MAJORITY CRYPTOCURRENCIES TAIL ALONG

Most cryptocurrencies have begun to spring towards gains as the year of 2023 made way into its second month. On Thursday, February 2, Bitcoin opened with a gain of three percent to trade at the price point of \$23,884 (roughly Rs. 19.5 lakh). On international exchanges, BTC reeled in gains of around 3.50 percent to trade at a similar value mark. In the last 24 hours, Bitcoin has grown by \$755 (roughly Rs. 61,782). With the price of BTC spiking, majority altcoins are reeling-in benefits.

Ether opened with gains larger than Bitcoin. The second most valued cryptocurrency rose in price by 5.42 percent on Thursday. As per the crypto price tracker by Gadgets 360, ETH is trading at the price point of \$1,670 (roughly Rs. 1.36 lakh). The cryptocurrency recorded a growth of \$87



(roughly Rs. 7,120) since its last day's pricing. Binance Coin, Cardano, Polygon, Solana, Polkadot, Litecoin, and Avalanche -- opened with gains. Shiba Inu and Dogecoin, both

the meme coins recorded small but significant profits. Meanwhile, stablecoins such as USD Coin and Binance USD emerged among the handful of altcoins that opened with losses today.

Chainlink, Leo, and Near Protocol also recorded price reductions.

Overall, the crypto market valuation rose by 3.78 percent in the last 24 hours. As per CoinMarketCap, the value of the global crypto sector currently stands at \$1.09 trillion (roughly Rs. 89,37,432 crore).

The year of 2023 has started on a positive note for cryptocurrencies, most of which are recovering from last year's downfall. Despite its element of volatility, the crypto sector has somehow kept itself safeguarded against a ban in the world's most populated nation, India. India got its union budget for the year of 2023-2024 on February 1, as part of which, finance minister Nirmala Sitharaman did not talk about restricting the crypto sector in the nation. In fact, Sitharaman did not particularly address the crypto topic at all, which left

players in the industry who were expecting tax reliefs, a tad disappointed.

"While many crypto industry leaders had big expectations for the union budget 23-24 and requested some key reforms such as lowering the TDS rate from 1 percent to 0.01 percent and providing clarity on taxation, I honestly did not have lofty hopes. It is best to wait until the Indian government fully comprehends what cryptocurrency is and the value it can bring to the Indian economy. Overall, this budget is very considerate knowing that the government is still trying to understand the crypto sector has somehow kept itself safeguarded the crypto and is not saying anything about the crypto," Kumar Gaurav, Founder and CEO of Cashaa told Gadgets 360. Launched in 2017, Cashaa is neo-bank that works with crypto businesses.

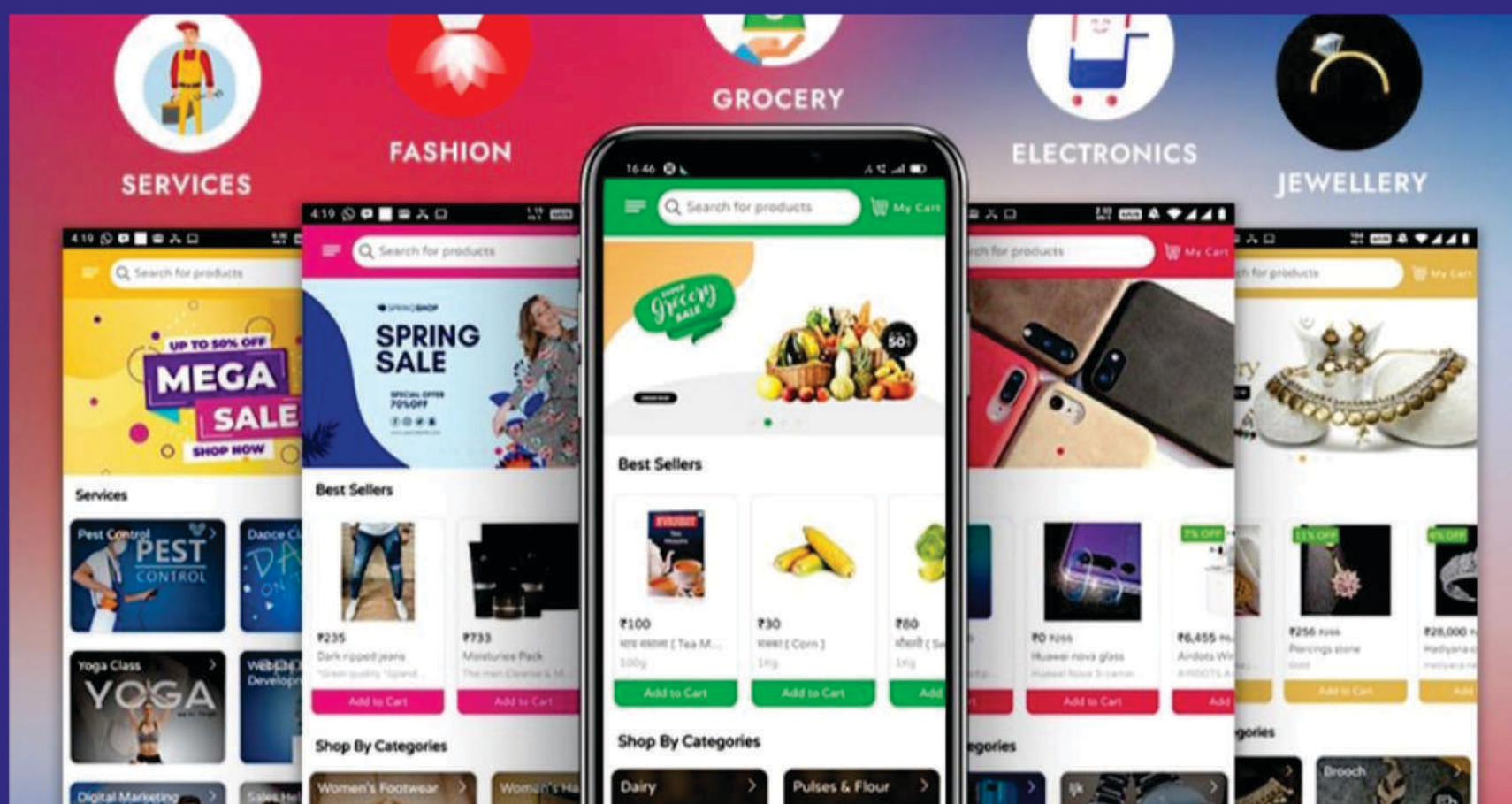

# ELON MUSK HAD 'HANDSHAKE DEAL' FOR TESLA TAKEOVER BEFORE POSTING 2018 TWEETS, FORMER AIDE SAYS

Elon Musk's former chief of staff on Wednesday testified that the billionaire believed he had a "handshake deal" to take Tesla private in 2018 shortly before he tweeted he had the financing for an aborted buyout that is still haunting him in a high-profile trial.

Sam Teller, who worked closely with Musk from 2014 to 2019, detailed a series of meetings that his former boss held with representatives from Saudi Arabia's Public Investment Fund. His remarks came during testimony that also shed light on the quirks of a billionaire who runs Tesla, rocket ship maker SpaceX and Twitter. Among other things, Teller said he sometimes had to "soften" Musk's blunt emails. Teller attributed Musk's brusque manner to Asperger's syndrome, a form of autism that Musk acknowledged having during a May 2021 television appearance hosting "Saturday Night Live."

Teller's testimony came on the ninth day of a trial triggered by a class-action lawsuit filed on behalf of Tesla shareholders alleging Musk



misled them with tweets in August 2018. In the tweets, Musk indicated he had locked up the money to lead a buyout of the electric automaker, ending its then eight-year history as a publicly held company. The case is scheduled to be turned over to the nine-person jury Friday. Musk, 51, spent much of his roughly eight hours on the witness stand earlier in the trial maintaining he had a valid reason for disclosing he had "funding secured" for a Tesla buyout in an Aug. 7, 2018 tweet at \$420 (roughly Rs. 34,400) deal — a price that valued the electric automaker at \$72 billion (roughly Rs. 5,89,300 crore)

at that time.

Teller was summoned to the stand Wednesday by Musk's lawyers in an attempt to substantiate and elaborate upon the billionaire's testimony.

In the last of five meetings held with Saudi fund that began in January 2017, Teller said Musk became increasingly excited as he discussed taking Tesla private with Yasir al-Rumayyan, a governor for the Saudi fund, during a July 31, 2018 meeting.

Although specific financing amounts were discussed, Teller recalled Musk pointing out to al-Rumayyan that taking Tesla private would be

expensive.

"Yasir was, like, 'Don't worry about it, we've got a lot of money,'" Teller said.

As he watched the two men happily conclude their meeting, Teller said, "It was my sense they made a handshake deal to proceed" with taking Tesla private.

A week later, Musk tweeted he had the money for the buyout shortly after being alerted that the Financial Times was about to publish a story disclosing the Saudi fund had built a 5% stake in Tesla — a stake that he knew about but hadn't been publicly announced.

Amid widespread confusion about whether Musk's Twitter account had been hacked or he was joking, Musk followed up a few hours later with another tweet suggesting a deal was imminent.

The prospect of Tesla stock being sold caused the shares to soar during a 10-day period covered by the shareholder lawsuit that led to the current trial. The stock price dropped after Musk scrapped the going-private proposal, resulting in billions of dollars in losses, based on the estimates provided in

testimony by an economist hired by the shareholder attorneys as an expert witness in the trial.

After the Securities and Exchange Commission alleged Musk's tweets were misleading, he and Tesla reached a \$40 million (roughly Rs. 300 crore) settlement in September 2018 without acknowledging wrongdoing. U.S. District Judge Edward Chen, who is presiding over the current trial, also has declared Musk's tweets to be falsehoods, leaving it to the jurors to decide if he posted them recklessly.

During his testimony, Teller revealed that Musk doesn't like anyone filtering information for him. "He is the type of CEO who likes to absorb his communications," Teller said.

Even so, Teller likened his job to an air traffic controller confronted with "a lot of problem solving" at all hours. "Most of my waking hours were working," Teller said, a gruelling schedule that led him to stop working for Musk in 2019. "I was pretty tired and it was time to do something else," Teller said.

## ONEPLUS 11 5G COLOUR OPTIONS, RAM AND STORAGE CONFIGURATIONS LEAK AHEAD OF INDIA LAUNCH

OnePlus 11 5G is confirmed to launch in India on February 7 during the OnePlus Cloud 11 event. In a new update, the colour options, and the RAM and storage configurations of the handset have been leaked online. The OnePlus 11 5G is tipped to be available in India in two RAM and storage options with up to 16GB of onboard memory and up to 256GB of storage. It is expected to come in Eternal Green and Titan Black

shades. To recall, the OnePlus 11 5G powered by Snapdragon 8 Gen 2 SoC was unveiled in China recently. It features a 120Hz LTPO 3.0 AMOLED screen with 2K resolution and has 100W SuperVOOC fast charging support.

Tipster Yogesh Brar (@heyitsyogesh), in association with Pricebaba, has leaked an alleged screenshot of OnePlus 11 5G's listing on OnePlus India

website. As per the screenshots, the OnePlus 11 5G will be offered in 8GB RAM + 128GB of storage and 16GB RAM + 256GB storage options in India. The purported listing, which isn't yet live for the public, suggests that the upcoming phone will be available in Eternal Green and Titan Black colour options. This is in line with the previous leaks.

The OnePlus 11 5G was launched in China last month

in three configurations. It is priced at CNY 3,999 (roughly Rs. 48,000) for the base 12GB RAM + 256GB storage variant and CNY 4,399 (roughly Rs. 53,000) for the 16GB RAM + 256GB storage model. The top-of-the-line 16GB RAM + 512GB storage option is priced at CNY 4,899 (roughly Rs. 59,000). It is available in China in Endless Black and Instant Blue colours.

OnePlus 11 5G specifications

The Chinese variant of OnePlus 11 5G runs on Android 13 with ColorOS 13.0 on top and features a 6.7-inch QHD+ (1,440x3,216 pixels) Samsung LTPO 3.0 AMOLED display with up to 120Hz adaptive refresh rate. Hasselblad triple rear camera setup led by a 50-megapixel Sony IMX890 primary sensor, 16-megapixel selfie sensor and up to 512GB storage are the other key specifications of the device.

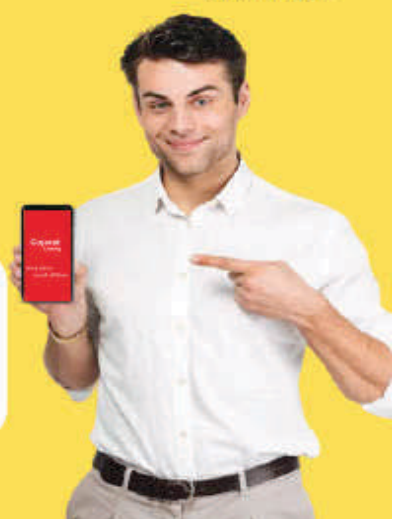
